Spring Onions are sweeter and more mellow than regular onions, with greens that are similar in flavor to scallions. Spring Onions look similar to scallions but have a small onion bulb at the base that can be red or white, depending on the variety. They are wonderful grilled, roasted whole, or used in place of pearl onions.

Red spring onions are sold by the 10# case only from Coke Farms. White spring onions will be available further into the season.
